

# Other Clinton County Burials

During the early years of the county many burials took place in family plots. Most of these have been removed to established cemeteries. Below is a list of known burials that were not or may not have been removed. Please contact me if you have further information on these or any other burials. (wsummers@edcen.ehhs.cmich.edu)

**Burial Locations:** These are all on private property.

*Cushman Cemetery* was on the Ira Cushman farm, Section 19, Bath Twp., near the southeast corner of Chandler and Clark Roads with burials in the 1830-1850's. At least some of the bodies were removed to other cemeteries. Some bones discovered by a utility company were removed to the Gunnisonville Cemetery. No markers. Land has been actively plowed and farmed.

*Eddy Burial Ground* was located on the north side of the river in Section 15 of Eagle Twp. No markers. Estimated to contain about a dozen graves.

*French Road Cemetery* was on the south side of French Road about ½ mile east of US 27. No markers.
