DEAR SIR:

We the undersigned honorably discharged Soldiers and Sailors of the Army and Navy of the United States, having served between the 12th day of April, 1861, and the 9th day of April, 1865, in the war for the suppression of the Rebellion, and eligible to membership in the Grand Army of the Republic, hereby make application for the organization of a Post of the Grand Army of the Republic at De Witt Clinton County Mich., to be known as Gen. W. Anderson Post No., Department of Michigan, and request that a Charter and necessary supplies be furnished for the same. Enclosed find Thirteen Dollars, Charter fee.

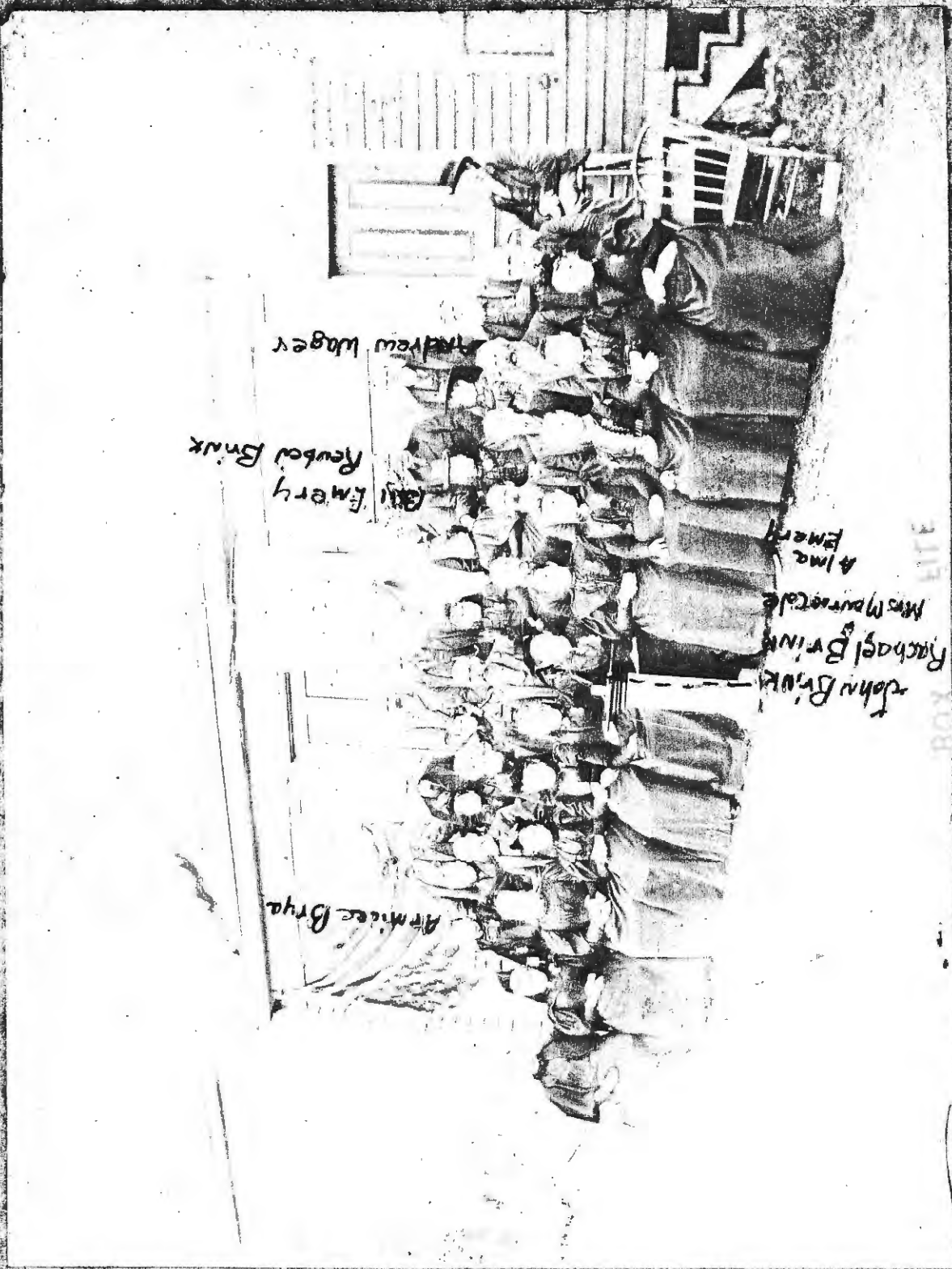
Dear Comrade, —
