Linn-Scott Collection These photographs were given by Dyle Linn to Ralph Woodruff in the 1950's. Many years later he turned them over to Mr. Linn's sons, Carrol & Traverse Linn in California. In 1983 Mr. Woodruff contacted the sons asking for a picture of their mother (Bessie Webb Linn) to add to a collection of Capt. David Scott's descendants being compiled by Ken Coin. They sent all these which Mr. Woodruff then gave to Mr. Coin. Three were returned to another Linn descendent, Syble (Scott) Shannon (a daughter of Bert & Byrl [Linn] Scott) and the remainder donated to the library.

It should be noted that the above Linn/Scott family is not connected to the family of Capt. David Scott- it was Bessie (Webb) Linn who was the descendent of Dewitt's founders.
