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# FOUND SKELETON

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**One Uncovered on Site of Old Indian  
Burial Ground at Dewitt.**

From Dewitt Correspondent:

While engaged in digging a drain for kitchen sewerage last week, about two feet below the surface and only a few feet from the door, Mr. Stalker unearthed a skeleton in good state of preservation. Beside the bones were found a hatchet and knife of American manufacture, and a tool fitting over the hand used for sharpening the knife. As the house has been built for a period of sixty years it is presumably the skeleton of an Indian, as some of the older people remember the land being the burial ground of the Indians. Many people have viewed the bones which are in a box at Mrs. Stalker's.
